DINNER TANGO SHOW AT QUERANDI SAN TELMO

The Querandí is an authentic icon of the city of Buenos Aires. It has been awarded by the Museum of the City, under the Secretary of Culture, with the title of "Living Testimony of Civic Memory" due to the authenticity and fidelity with which its restoration was carried out in 1992, after remaining abandoned for more than 12 years. It has also been honored as a "Notable Bar and Restaurant of the City of Buenos Aires" and distinguished as a "Tourist Site of Interest" by the Ministry of Tourism of Argentina.

The excellence and skill of our distinguished dancers will fill the main hall with all the magic of tango, along with its history and fascinating tradition. Our proposal for a tango dinner show in San Telmo, in the historic center of the city, encapsulates the very essence of Buenos Aires in its early 20th-century architecture. Its art-deco facade, Solomonic columns, checkered floors, shields, and arches invite you to transport yourself to another time, to savor the most representative dishes from each region of our country accompanied by renowned Argentine wines, and to enjoy the most authentic and passionate tango show in the City of Buenos Aires.

CITY TOUR

Some of the areas we cover with the city tour are:

Plaza de Mayo: home of the National Government Palace & the Metropolitan Cathedral. The historical, political, and foundational epicenter of the city. A great starting point for the city tour.

San Telmo: one of BA's oldest neighborhoods. It boasts a vibrant tango and arts scene. Its antique markets, candle street lighting, cobblestones, and old buildings with original facades and décor, all add to the unique bohemian atmosphere. Sundays buzz with activity as the main antique market comes alive around the Plaza Dorrego.

La Boca: famous for the brightly-painted houses and 'conventillos' (communal housing tenements) on the 'Caminito' street and the legendary Boca Juniors football club where Diego Maradona made his name.

Puerto Madero: situated on the riverside along the Río de la Plata in a former commercial dock, it is the city's youngest neighborhood and a major gastronomic and business hub.

Along the canals, former industrial warehouses have been converted into elegant bars, eateries, and offices in one of the most successful urban waterfront restoration projects in the world.

Palermo: the largest neighborhood in town, home to huge parks and some of the city's trendiest bars, clubs, and fashion boutiques. With nearly 350 acres of parks, lakes and wooded areas, Palermo's eastern side is a peaceful retreat from the heady rush of the downtown area.

Recoleta: the most refined and European style districts of Buenos Aires and probably what people have in mind when they refer to Buenos Aires as "the Paris of the south". Its tree-lined avenues are home to fashionable restaurants, cafes, boutiques, malls, galleries, and luxury hotels. The Cemetery is one of the main attractions, the final resting place for generations of Argentine well-known citizens like Evita Peron.

On the tour we will see the access to the yacht clubs on the banks of the Luján River; the surprising houses and mansions located in the ravines and their magnificent views of the Plata estuary. Among the main references located on the coast we highlight the Cathedral of San Isidro; the Port of Olivos; the Monumental de River stadium; the University City of Buenos Aires and the permanent aerial parade of departures and arrivals at the Metropolitan Airport.

SANTA SUSANA GAUCHO PARTY

Arrival at the Estancia starting at 11:00 a.m., they will receive you in the grocery store with empanadas and drinks that are available until 1:00 p.m. During the morning, cart rides through the countryside are offered, visiting the ranch center, which is a Spanish colonial museum, visiting the chapel, enjoying the parks and even the 1,300-hectare countryside. Starting at 1:00 p.m., the typical lunch begins with free food and drinks. At the end there is a tango and folklore show with malambo de boleadoras. After lunch, a gaucho show takes place in the field with an exhibition of herds, ring races and stable races. Finally, in the park they will offer you Creole pastries with cooked mate and sodas. Ending 4:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.
