## TOURS AND ACTIVITIES

### CATARATAS DEL IGUAZU

#### Included services:

- Air ticket by Aerolíneas Argentinas with 1 piece of luggage of 15kg checked
  - Departs from Buenos Aires on april 27th at 09.45a.m – Arrives in Iguazu at 11.40 a.m
  - Departs from Iguazu on 29th april at 03.40 p.m – Arrives in Buenos Aires at 05.40 p.m
- Transfer in/out: Airport – Hotel - Airport
- 2 nights at selected hotel with breakfast included
- **27th april:** Brasillian Falls
  - From 01.30 p.m – to 06.30 p.m  
10,000 meters walk along footbridges with panoramic view. Transfers from / to the hotel. The morning departure also includes a stop at Rafain Churrascaria, a typical Brazilian restaurant, to enjoy the best buffet in the area.
- **28th april:** Anrgentinian Falls
  - *Upper Walkway: access to the magnificent view of the falls and the Iguazu River delta formed by a group of lush islands. Duration: 1.15 hs. Difficulty: no stairs.*
  - *Lower Walkway: a set of strategically designed walkways that allow the most diverse views of the falls and an intimate encounter with the waterfalls and charming corners of the jungle. Duration: 2 hours. Difficulty: with stairs.*
  - *Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat): indescribable for its beauty and energy, it offers an impressive mix of sounds and landscapes. Duration: 1.30 hs. Difficulty: without stairs.*
  - *Jungle Train: a circuit of ecological trains in the middle of the jungle and bordering the river that allows the visitor to move within the park and reach the accesses of walkways and attractions.*

## EL CALAFATE

### Incluye:

- Air ticket by Aerolíneas Argentinas with 1 piece of luggage of 15kg checked
  - Departs from Buenos Aires on 27th april at 05.20 a.m – Arrives in El Calafate at 08.40 a.m
  - Departs from El Calafate on 29th april at 02.15 p.m – Arrives in Buenos Aires at 05.15 p.m
- Transfer in/out: Airport – Hotel - Airport
- 2 nights at selected hotel with breakfast included
- **27th april:** Brasillian Falls
  - 2:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. with snack.
  - *The Calafate Extremo excursion is a similar variant to the Balcón de Calafate 4x4 excursion.*
  - *Excursion in 4x4 vehicles with capacity for up to 8 passengers.*
  - *Ascent to Cerro Huyliche, 10 minutes from El Calafate, within the Huyliche Ranch. You can access outstanding panoramic points in the area, at about 900 meters high.*
  - *From the balconies of El Calafate you can see Lake Argentino, the city of El Calafate, the Fitz Roy and Torre hills, Punta Bandera and the source of the Perito Moreno glacier.*
  - *The route presents a site made up of sedimentary rock from the late Cretaceous period, splinters of petrified wood, shark teeth, marine oysters and fossilized bones that testify to the prehistoric past and give value to the journey.*
  - *Different stops are made to observe, enjoying viewpoints and the stand. In this place there is a lunch service in the morning and a snack in the afternoon. You can also observe condors, eagles, guanacos or foxes depending on the time of year.*
- **28th april: POR LA MAÑANA:** Perito Moreno Regular Excursion
  - *Time Range: from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.*
  - *Duration: 8 hours (may vary depending on weather conditions).*
  - *Difficulty: Medium / Low.*
  - *Technical equipment: waterproof jacket, hat and gloves, trekking boots, backpack, sunglasses and sunscreen.*
  - *Everything starts early in the morning when the transfer picks up each passenger at their respective hotel. Once on board, we will head towards Los Glaciares National Park, a journey of approximately 80 km.*
  - *Upon entering the Park, we will make stops at viewpoints to contemplate incredible views of the glacier. During the trip we will be accompanied by a guide authorized by the National Park "Los Glaciares", who will give us all the information about the environment, history and mysticism of this unique glacier.*
  - *Once we arrive at the parking lot of the park, you will have free time to start touring the exciting circuits walking along the trails allowed to view from different angles the imposing Perito Moreno Glacier, whose detachments and continuous noises speak of a permanent forward movement.*
  - *For this excursion the passenger will have to choose to eat at the restaurant in the park or take a snack.*

**OPTIONAL TOURS:**

- **APRIL 28TH**, instead of Perito Moreno National Park, you could choose one of this up-grades
  - **BLUE SAFARI:**
    - *Level of complexity: Low.*
    - *Duration: approximately 8 hours (full day).*
    - *Clarification: this excursion does NOT include hiking on the Perito Moreno Glacier.*
    - *The excursion begins in El Calafate when the bus departs for Los Glaciares National Park. Once in Puerto Bajo de las Sombras, only 7 km from the footbridges, we will take a boat to cross Lago Rico and, after sailing for 20 minutes, we will disembark on the opposite shore.*
    - *Little by little we will walk for 30 minutes always with a view to the south wall of the Glacier in case we are surprised by a thunderous detachment. Once next to the ice, it will be time for an unforgettable experience... We will be able to fully enjoy its intense and varied blues, whites, and whimsical shapes!*
    - *The total hike is approximately 1.5 hours through a natural terrain of sand and stones with some slopes and stairs. The tour, of a kilometer and a half, will be along the shore of the lake and through a lush forest overlooking the glacier.*
    - *Finally, we will take the boat to appreciate the water and, a few meters away, the entire south face of the glacier and be able to see every detail of the icy marble wall.*
    - *Once at the port, we will take the bus to the footbridges where we will have 2 hours to enjoy the incredible panoramic view. You can also take advantage of this time to eat the lunch that you will have to bring from El Calafate.*
    - *We will arrive in El Calafate after crossing the Patagonian steppe.*
  - **MINITREKKING :**
    - *IMPORTANT: Children under Minitrekking will need authorization from their parents if they are not accompanied by adults. It is MANDATORY to present complete data on all parents: name and surname, DNI number or passport, birth certificate and nationality*
    - *Menor: 8 to 15 years old (shoes no. 35 minimum). Up to 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult. // Maximum age: up to 65 years old.*
    - *Everything starts early in the morning when the transfer picks up each passenger at their respective hotel. Once on board, we set off for Los Glaciares National Park. Upon entering the park, we head for the Bajo de las Sombras port, approximately 6 km. before the glacier viewpoint, where we embark to cross the Rico Lake, arriving at the southwest coast after approximately 20 minutes of navigation, in front of the south wall of the Perito Moreno glacier. It is there where the adventure begins.*
    - *Upon arrival at the base of the Glacier, the guides assign each passenger to a group. There will begin a talk about glaciology accompanied by a description of the crossing and the precautions to be taken into account when walking on the glacier. Once the crampons are put on, the mythical walk on the majestic Perito Moreno begins.*
    - *Enjoy a walkway with unique views of the Perito Moreno Glacier. At the end of the minitrekking, we return to the port where the vehicle awaits us with a National Park guide to start the tour that will take us to the walkways in front of the Perito Moreno Glacier. After entering the Andean Patagonian Forest area, we will stop at the Curva de los Suspiros. Then we continue to the walkways that run along the entire front of the glacier, where we will have free time to walk along them and enjoy incredible views and breaks of the glacier in the middle of the millennial and lush Andean Patagonian Forest.*
    - **Who can NOT do Minitrekking:**
      - - Pregnant women.
      - - People over 65 years old or under 8 years old.
      - - Have any cardiac history (by pass, stent, pre-infarction, any heart operation, etc).
      - - Having had a stroke.
      - - Have any walking problems (meniscus, knee or leg joint problems, limping, etc.).
      - - Have had any operation during your life (spine, hips, legs, arms, etc). Inform the guide/vendor.
      - - Having motor problems.
      - - Considerable excess weight.
      - - Respiratory problems (easily agitated).
      - - Elderly women: have osteoporosis.
      - - Having: epilepsy, fainting, dizziness, vertigo.
      - - Indicate if you take any medication.
